Dear All,

There have been some questions regarding the Qualification System for the 2019 Pan Am Games in Lima. I hope to clarify these questions here.

All athletes in the 4 events of CSL will be able to double in CSLX.

CSL MK1 and MC1 can compete in CSLX MK1

CSL WK1 and WC1 can compete in CSLX WK1

- 1- There are 5 athlete quota places for CSLX MK1 and 5 athlete quota places for WK1. These athlete quota places are set up in order to help NOC's / National Federations who do not have a CSL program and are better at whitewater kayaking to qualify for the Pan Am Games.
- 2- We are working on filling these athlete quota places with new NOC's/National Federations. However, if we do not, NOC's/National Federations may be able to qualify a third boat in CSLX in Tres Coroas because of the leftover CSLX quota allocation.
- 3- NOC's/National Federations wanting to receive an athlete quota place reallocation in CSLX would enter an athlete in the CSLX competition, this athlete would not be able to double in the Canoe Slalom competition at the Games.
- 4- All athletes entered in CSLX at the Games will compete in the CSLX Time Trials. However, only one athlete per NOC's/National Federation with the best time trial result will move on to the brackets.
