Manager

- Identify Venue for each Discipline
- Develop and establish SME (Subject Matter Experts) /Legacy

General

- Develop Educational Program for both discipline (Administration, Technical, NTO)
- Liaison between organizing committee, COPAC/ICF, NF
- Develop a Master plan with all the activities in alignment with the Timetable of the Games.
- Set progress indicators
 - Communication between the different stakeholders
- Make and analysis of the fundings needed for the implementation of this activities.
