2.0 – TRES COROAS AND VENUE TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Três Coroas is a Brazilian municipality in the state of Rio Grande do Sul. It is in the Metropolitan Region of Porto Alegre (Capital of State) and in the Gramado-Canela Microregion, more precisely in the River Paranhana Valley, an average altitude of 56 meters.

Três Coroas estimated population in 2021 was 28,948 inhabitants. It has an area of 185,535 km². The Paranhana River crosses the city. The main road access is via RS-115, with alternative access highway RS-020. The city's economy is oriented towards the

production of women's shoes and ecotourism, with a Human Development Index HDI – 0.710, considered high.

The municipality of Três Coroas belongs to the climate zone designated by the letter C, on the border of the Cfa and Cfb climate types, according to the Köppen climate classification. These climate types are characterized as a warm humid subtropical climate (Cfa) and a warm humid subtropical climate (Cfb). The average temperature is 20°C and the average rainfall in this climate is 2,000 mm/year, with July being the wettest month, with 157.2 mm, and April the driest, with 97.2 mm.

Tourism in the city has been boosted by natural attractions such as the Paranhaná River, Parque das Laranjeiras, the mountains, adventure sports such as rafting, mountain biking and climbing, and the only Tibetan Buddhist temple in South America, or temple Chagdud Gonpa. Khadro Ling, located in the mountains and open to the public.

The main attractions are the Paranhaná River and natural parks such as Parque das Laranjeiras, Raft Adventure and Brasil Raft Park, located in the municipality, in the district of “Linha Café”.

The municipality is served by the RS-115 and RS-020 highways. The city of Três Coroas is 90 km from the capital Porto Alegre, where is located the “Salgado Filho International Airport” (IATA: POA, ICAO: SBPA). It is the largest and busiest airport in the state of Rio Grande do Sul and the ninth busiest in Brazil in terms of the number of passengers carried.

The “Oswaldo Diesel Philanthropic Hospital” is the only one in the city. The City Hall maintains some health posts located in the center and in some neighborhoods, even offering care in the Parque das Laranjeiras.

Laranjeira's Park was created for the Canoeing Slalom Senior World Championship in 1997, on the banks of the Paranhana River. It currently offers ecotourism activities such as rafting, aquaride, climbing activities. It has six adventure companies working with activities and counts with developed receptive structure with accommodation, food, toilets and local signage. In addition, the Park offers complete infrastructure for camping and recreation, with soccer fields, volleyball court, grill and barbecue areas.

The Complex has police and security 24/7 hours!

These venues and services are part of the legacy of the World Championship (1997). Currently, they are maintained by the City Council of Três Coroas in partnership with the “Associação Três Coroense de Canoagem – ASTECA”, a local club in operation since the 1980s, being responsible for the administration of the Park (concession granted by the City Council) and for the development of canoeing and extreme kayaking in the municipality, one of the main canoeing centers of Brazil.

The Slalom course is semi-artificial, 300 meters long, WW level Class II - III, with an approximate volume of 10/15 cubic meters, controlled by a hydroelectric dam.

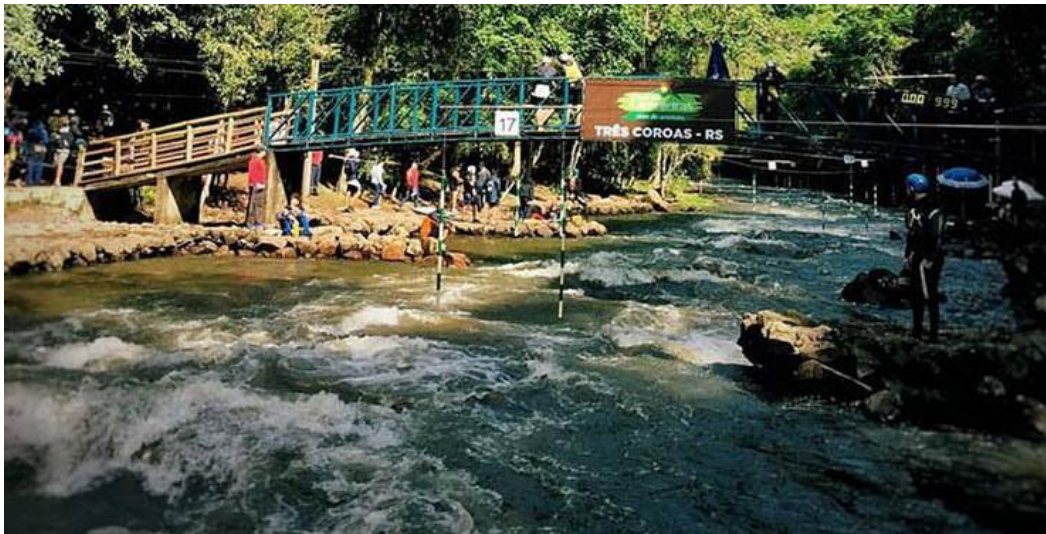


Photo 4 – Slalom Course

3.0 - COURSE

- Course: - Laranjeira's Park, located 14 km (30 minutes) from Três Coroas downtown.
- Water control: The Canastra Hydroelectric 3,5 km above the course can provide a steady flow of up to 15 m³/s, depending on the electric power generation demands.

4.0 - COMPETITION AREA

- Warm-up area: Immediately above the course there is warm-up area suitable for that purpose.
- Cool-down area: The area under the finish line is suitable for athletes to cool-down.
- Course length: 220 meters
- Course Drop: 3,15 meters
- Flow: from 10 to 15 m³/s
- Width: 15 to 20 m

5.0 - ACCREDITATION, TRAINING AND COMPETITION

- Accreditation center: accreditation will be located at the Laranjeira's Park
- Training Period: Training will be available for any athletes participating in the competition without any limitation. There should be water flow variations during the day and along the training period.
- **First training period:** 20 – 31 March 2023;
- **Official training period:** 21 – 26 April 2023

***Entry fee to competition - U\$45.00. This fee includes 5 days of official training.**

**Another period out of official training,
\$5.00 per day.**

- The competition will be open with no limitation for competitors per country.
- The organizing committee of the competition will inform 10 days in advance or earlier about any atypical situation that may occur, such as: floods, droughts, etc.
- This will be an ICF Ranking Race (Level – 3). Therefore, entries must be made through SDP – Sports Data Platform - of ICF by the National Federations. For access, <https://icf.msl.es/icf/main.jsp>. Federation Username and Password required.
- **IMPORTANT REMINDER** regarding World Cup, World Championships and Olympic Games participation (ICF Canoe Slalom Competition Rules 2023):
 - APPENDIX 5 – World Cup Entry Policy: To enter an ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup in Canoe & Kayak events in 2023 an Athlete must be listed on the current ICF Canoe & Kayak World Ranking.
 - CSL 2023 Competition Rules: 13.2.4 - To be eligible to enter an athlete at the World Championships (for senior events only) a National Federation must have entered at least one athlete in the same event at the previous Continental Championships or a designated competition by the concerned continental association.
 - CSL 2023 Competition Rules: 12.4 - To be eligible to compete at the Olympic Games an athlete must have been ranked on the ICF Canoe Slalom World Rankings in at least one event that they participate in.

Numerical entries will be accepted until March 13th, 2023.

Nominal entries will be accepted until April 14th, 2023.

6.0 - VISAS

- For VISAs, please send an e-mail to guilherme.brito@canoagem.org.br with copy to andre@tecnoeletrica.com.br. The following information is required: family name, given name, date of birth, passport number, position (ITO for officials) and Brazilian consulate the applicant wishes to apply the VISA. We will provide a letter of request for the Brazilian Consulate to fully support the application with copy to the applicant. Preferably, send a copy of your passport as well. You can check if a VISA is required by consulting the following link - <http://www.portalconsular.itamaraty.gov.br/images/qgrv/QGRV-simples-ingJun11.pdf> . Number 8 means “Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days” and # means – “Entrance allowed by presenting Civil Identity Card” (no passport required).

9.0 - ARRIVAL AIRPORT

To get to Três Coroas, "Salgado Filho - Airport" in Porto Alegre City (Capital of the Rio Grande do Sul State) is the best option.

The airport receives direct flights from South America, for the countries of Central America and North America it will be necessary to catch a connection flight in the cities of Rio de Janeiro or São Paulo.

10.0 - BOAT AND ATHLETES TRANSPORTATION

- Transfer service will be offered for the teams, provided only if requested in advance, to optimize the number of athletes on the trips aiming to reduce costs. Details will be announced in Bulletin #2.
Countries interested in using the transfer should send the estimated number of athletes, number of boats and expected arrival date to vit.vanicek@canoagem.org.br.
The estimated value per trip will be approximately R\$ 1,000.00 for up to 8 people and up to 10 boats.
- Teams and athletes may also rent cars at the airport and stay independent of the competition transportation system.
